A WORD FROM THE DIRECTOR FOR IRELAND

'Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus.'

Philippians 2:5

Paul references the mind 12 times in Philippians, making the mind a major theme in this epistle. One's "mind" is the way one thinks and that influences all behaviour. We must *think* Christianity before we can act it.

The Humble Mind 2:5:

Humility is another theme in Philippians, presenting Jesus as our example. Interestingly, Jesus begins His teaching in Matthew 5: 3 with humility. Peter reminds us, "All of you be submissive to one another and be clothed with humility, for God resists the proud, but gives grace to the humble." 1 Peter 5: 5.

The Harmonious Mind 2:2:

This is found in the immediate context of humility 2:5-11.
Paul is emphasising unity.
This reminds us of Psalm
133:1, where the Psalmist uses the picture of musical

instruments being tuned to orchestra pitch, producing a harmonious sound which is pleasant to the ear. Unfortunately, the world we are endeavouring to reach criticises us for our divisions.

The Mature Mind 3:15:

"I press on" the determined apostle states in 3:12 but underlying this is Paul's desire to know Jesus better 3:10, where he is confronted with humility in the person of Christ, as seen in chapter 2. This is in stark contrast to his old life 3:5-6 where humility was in short supply. Humility has major implications in the arena of Christian maturity.

The Peaceful Mind 4:7:

Paul tells us to turn our cares to prayers in the midst of much that would cause anxiety, so that we may experience the peace of God from the God of peace.

Humble people strive for unity which displays Christian maturity, producing a believer who is a peaceloving person. "And the harvest of righteousness (of conformity to God's will in thought and deed) is [the fruit of the seed] sown in peace bu those who work for and make peace [in themselves and in others, that peace which means concord, agreement, and harmony between individuals, with undisturbedness, in a peaceful mind free from fears and agitating passions and moral conflicts?". James 3:18 (AMPC)

May these Christian characteristics give you power in the place of prayer as you use this Prayer Diary from January – March.




