# A WORD FROM THE DIRECTOR FOR ENGLAND



In this little summary of Jesus ministry, Mathew gives us a glimpse into Jesus' emotional stance towards his work. "When he saw the crowds, he had compassion on them, because they were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd." Matthew 9 v 35-38.

The word translated, 'compassion' that Mathew uses here is very graphic it was a reference to the gut. We understand it better if we were to say that 'Jesus was gutted as he looked at the crowd.'

We know what it is like to be so overwhelmed with grief that we feel sick to our stomach. Recently my son and his fiancé visited Auschwitz. There is a certain place along the tour where the hair, shoes and prosthetics of the victims are still on display. All who see

it say the same thing: it's truly sickening. This is but a pale reflection of how Jesus was moved as He saw with divine accuracy the havoc that sin has had upon the human race.

Those who felt His healing touch, must have been astonished, not just by His power but also by his compassion, both of which were a foreign concept to the pagan and most of the contemporary Jews. Their understanding of God had become so skewed that He was anything but compassionate and kind.

What is our attitude towards the unbelieving masses as they live in ignorance or in defiance of the shepherd?

Francis Schaeffer once said, "*biblical orthodoxy without compassion is the ugliest thing in the world.*" It is all

too easy for us to forget the pit from which the Lord Jesus pulled us. To stand in our sanitised bubble and feel 'righteous'. It is a well-worn but true statement: "*people won't care what you know until they know that you care.*"

A lot of helpful material has been written about effective evangelism in the 21st century and we would do well to pay attention to it, but one of the greatest needs for every Christian to foster is a deep and tangible compassion for those who haven't yet come to the Lord Jesus. May God give us compassionate hearts for those who don't yet know Him!
