A WORD FROM THE DIRECTOR

Ephesians 6:19-20 *and also for me, that words may be given to me in opening my mouth boldly to proclaim the mystery of the gospel, for which I am an ambassador in chains, that I may declare it boldly, as I ought to speak.*

If you were enduring Roman imprisonment in the first century and you were asked, "How can we pray for you" how would you respond? The answer to that question might be something like "pray that I may get out of here and back to business as usual!" Forget imprisonment... if you were to be asked the same question in the comfort of your own home today, the answer that you give would reveal your priorities.

In Ephesian 6:19 the apostle Paul, while under house arrest asks the church in Ephesus to pray that he would be effective where he is and that he would see the Gospel take strides into the Roman Empire which it does!

There is a threefold request.

That Utterance Would Be Given

Paul is asking his fellow believers that they would pray for him that he would have 'opportunity' to spread the Good News! Paul's overarching concern in life isn't his own freedom comfort and ease, but that the Gospel would advance!

To Make It Known

Paul wants to communicate this life-giving message in a way that is understandable. He says to the Colossians in 4v4 'pray that I may proclaim it clearly as I should'. Rico Tice said, "Right at the heart of the Christian Gospel we are saved from hell through the cross, for Heaven". We may have an open door of opportunity and a ready audience, but be fuzzy about the truth - what a travesty! The only proper response to the 'Good News' is to repent and believe!

Speak It Out

The number one reason that Christians give for not actively sharing their faith is fear. Paul asks for boldness. In fact, he mentions the need for boldness twice in one sentence! He probably does so because he wasn't feeling very courageous. I find this an encouragement and I am sure you do too. As you read the accounts in this Prayer Diary, can I encourage you to pray for us in the same manner which Paul asks the Ephesians to pray for him. Pray for, more opportunities, clarity as we speak the Gospel and boldness despite the opposition.

Events

As the spring starts to emerge, numerous events are planned for the edifying of God's people or to present the hope of the Gospel. Do pray for the Gospel Truck as it embarks on a busy itinerary of shows and events with great outreach potential. Remember also the planning for Bangor Convention, that it will be used by God to lead people in the next step of their walk with God. Plans are also being made for a variety of summer camps at our various centres across the UK and Ireland. Pray for those who intend to book and for those who will be appointed to prepare teaching sessions.

Bookshops

For many years, The Faith Mission's bookshops in Scotland and Northern Ireland have been places where people discovered the Gospel, explored faith through books or café conversations, found encouragement, and received support for ministry. The staff have worked with dedication, not only selling books but sharing faith, praying with customers and providing helpful resources. This legacy is deeply meaningful.

But the retail market has changed a lot, especially since Covid. Like many other bookshops in the UK, The Faith Mission's shops have faced fewer visitors, higher costs and more people shopping online.

As Trustees, our priority is to steward the Mission's resources wisely to ensure we fulfil our core mission and charitable goals. For this reason, a formal consultation has recently begun with bookshop staff about the future of the remaining bookshops. All feedback will be carefully considered before deciding on next steps.

This is a difficult time for our staff, and we are making sure they get the support and care that they need. We also ask for your prayers for everyone impacted and for the Mission during this period. Our bookshops are still open as usual, and we look forward to welcoming our customers.

The Faith Mission's evangelism and training work continues across the UK and Ireland. Our Bible College in Edinburgh continues to train the next generation for ministry, including a new scholarship programme for those called to evangelistic work.

For nearly 140 years, The Faith Mission has been passionately committed to sharing the unchanging message of the Gospel, particularly in the villages and rural areas across the UK and Ireland. That commitment continues. So do pray with us, that we might know how to remain relevant and effective in reaching people in the coming days.
