## A WORD FROM THE GENERAL DIRECTOR

One of the drawbacks of being a Member of The Faith Mission is that from time to time you are expected to stay in someone's home due to particular circumstances or the ministry that you are conducting.

I have a particular intolerance to cats, and on one occasion when moving to England many years ago, we found ourselves staying with a lovely lady (who became a good friend) but she had a great love for the feline variety. It took much patience and a sense of humour to see us through our time in that house. However many important lessons were learned along the way.

God was obviously working in Peter's life. At Joppa (Acts 9:36) Peter was used to raise Tabitha from the dead. He then found himself remaining in the area, but staying with Simon the Tanner. The significant fact here is that as a Jew, Peter would have struggled to be in that very home. It would have smelt of death, the odours of drying leather would have been a constant reminder of Jewish law. But here

also, Peter was able to withdraw from the demands of busy ministry and meet afresh with God. He was also prepared to set aside his reservations at the Tannery and allow God to work in his life.

God knew that Peter was in that home. In ch10, through Cornelius, men were sent to summons Peter. Within a day, Peter had received a fresh revelation from God, ch10:10, enabling Peter to understand that the Gospel was not limited to Jews, but for all people.

Sometimes God uses our environments to speak to us about what really matters in life. The Tannery was the starting point which God used to challenge Peter afresh. So for whatever strange places we find ourselves staying in over the summer, may the smells, and circumstances be used of the Lord to remind us that God favours no-one, and desires that all should be saved.

## Bookshops

---

Many have been concerned and praying for our bookshop ministry. Following a recent Board meeting, the Trustees have approved a model that places the shops on a sustainable footing and equips them for the next chapter of ministry.

Faith Mission Bookshops can continue and grow if churches and communities choose to collaborate with the mission. We are appointing a dedicated church worker to build those relationships, and we warmly invite churches to partner with the bookshops. To source resources through their local shop, to visit and meet our staff, and to consider how their congregations might support this work through prayer, retail sales, and volunteering.

### *What Is Changing*

- Our Edinburgh shop and café will function under a different operator whose vision and values align with ours. This is an ongoing discussion.
- Our Dunfermline shop will be repurposed into a ministry hub, reaching out with the gospel into the town and run by a separate Christian charity.
- Our Portadown shop and café will transition to a sustainable model of a bookshop with a smaller self-service catering offering.
- A web shop will launch as a dedicated channel and part of the renewed operation.

These decisions affect valued colleagues, and we are prioritizing our support for them, as well as every member of staff, through this period of change.

Our remaining shops across Northern Ireland will continue to trade and we value your support and prayers.
